- A description of filming activity
- Brief shot list of featured locations
- Approximate filming days
- Estimated budget
- Is project greenlit
- Scouting other states
- Is a Location Manager on broad
- How far able to travel beyond the <u>Los Angeles 30-Mile Studio Zone or Secondary</u>
 <u>Zone</u>
- Full contact information in signature block format with name, title, production company name, address, phone numbers, website and emails
